Opportunities for Public Comment on Duke Energy's CPCN Case

WHAT: The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (Commission) will hold two field hearings on Thursday, April 17, 2025, one in Bloomington and one in Terre Haute to hear from the public on the certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) petition of Duke Energy Indiana, LLC (Duke Energy) under [Cause No. 46193](#).

WHY: Duke Energy has filed a petition before the Commission requesting the issuance of a CPCN to construct two combined cycle natural gas units at the Cayuga generating station and other related cost recovery.

HOW: During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the Commission or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the Commissioners and Judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case.
