COMMENTS OF THE INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION
ON BROADBAND SERVICE AVAILABILITY DATA FOR INDIANA


I. Introduction

On December 5, 2012, the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") released a Public Notice (DA 12-1961) that solicited comments on areas shown as unserved by broadband service on the National Broadband Map, which is data to be used by the FCC to determine eligibility for future rounds of Connect America Phase I incremental support. The FCC Wireline Competition Bureau prepared a list of potentially eligible census blocks based on the National Broadband Map, as of December 2011. Comments were initially due January 4, 2013. On December 10, 2012, the FCC released a second Public Notice extending the due date for comments to January 9, 2012.

II. Comments

The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission has obtained updated broadband availability data from the Indiana Office of Technology (IOT), which is the entity that collects and maintains data on broadband availability in Indiana. This updated Indiana broadband availability data is current as of October 2012, making it more recent than the data referenced by the FCC in the public notice (December 2011). The IURC respectfully submits this updated Indiana data for the FCC's consideration in determining CAF Phase I funding. Because of its detailed and voluminous nature, the updated broadband availability data is contained in ESRI file format on the attached CD-ROM.
