

The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (the "Commission" or "IURC"), pursuant to IC 8-1-1-3(g) and 4-22-2.5-2, hereby readopts 170 IAC 1-1.1 regarding practice and procedure before the Commission and 170 IAC 5-1-15 regarding creditworthiness, deposits, and refunds for natural gas.

A notice of intent was published on April 25, 2012 in the Indiana Register. No requests for any part of this readoption to be separate from this action were submitted in writing within 30 days of this publication. On June 6, 2012, at 2:00 p.m. EDT in the IURC Conference Center Suite 220, PNC Center, Indianapolis, Indiana, a majority of the members of the Commission were present and adopted the foregoing rule.

The Commission's General Counsel shall forward copies of the attached rule to the Indiana Legislative Services Agency for publication in the Indiana Register.






