GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION 2023-06

WHEREAS, in accordance with Indiana Code section 8-1-2-65, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") must keep a record of all its proceedings and formal investigations and "all testimony shall be taken down by the stenographer appointed by the [Commission]."

WHEREAS, the Commission employs two full time court reporters to meet the stenography statutory requirement and the court reporters' transcripts are received in evidence as a "true and correct transcript" of the proceedings pursuant to Indiana Code section 8-1-2-66.

WHEREAS, parties may request copies of transcripts and in accordance with Indiana Code sections 4-22-4-1(a) and 8-1-3-8, transcript fees are the property of the Commission court reporter who prepared the transcript.

WHEREAS, transcripts are "furnished on the terms fixed by the [Commission] to any party to such investigation" under Indiana Code section 8-1-2-67 and the Commission may set the cost of preparing transcripts through a general administrative order under Indiana Code section 8-1-3-8.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Schedule of Transcript Fees Pursuant to Indiana Code section 8-1-3-8, which is attached to the General Administrative Order as Appendix A, is adopted by this Commission, and GAO 2017-1 is hereby superseded, both effective as of October 1, 2023.

APPENDIX A

Schedule of Transcript Fees Pursuant to Indiana Code section 8-1-3-8

I. Applicability

Effective October 1, 2023, these fees apply to transcripts of records of proceedings before the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") and documentation to perfect appeals, when prepared by the court reporters employed by the Commission. If the Commission utilizes contract court reporters, fees shall be set out in the contract.

II. Fees

For the original transcription of part or all of the record of a proceeding,	
per page	
For additional copies of an original transcript, per page	
For producing all other documents necessary to constitute a complete record of	
proceedings for the purposes of perfecting an appeal to the Indiana Court of	
Appeals or Supreme Court of Indiana, including but not limited to pleadings,	
orders, certification, etc., per page	
For mounting and incorporating exhibits and other documents and other	
services requested in connection with preparation of a complete records of the	
proceedings for purposes of perfecting an appeal to the Indiana Court of	
Appeals or Supreme Court of Indiana, including but not limited to pleadings,	
orders, certification, etc., per hour	
For transcripts provided by midnight local time of a running record or a	
proceeding which occurred that day, per page	
For transcripts of a record provided by the next business day, per page	
For transcripts of a record provided within three (3) business days, per page	

III. Requests from Indigent Parties

Pursuant to Indiana Code section 4-22-4-1(b), in cases of indigent parties who comply with that statute's provisions, transcript fees shall be paid from the State of Indiana General Fund.
