PETITION OF DUKE ENERGY INDIANA, LLC, PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 8-1-8.4, REQUESTING (1) A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR FEDERALLY-MANDATED COAL COMBUSTION RESIDUALS ("CCR") RULE COMPLIANCE PROJECTS AND COSTS, (2) APPROVAL OF ESTIMATED COSTS OF ITS FEDERALLY-MANDATED COMPLIANCE PROJECTS, (3) AUTHORITY TO REFLECT COSTS AND CREDITS INCURRED FOR THE FEDERALLY-MANDATED PROJECTS THROUGH ITS EXISTING STANDARD CONTRACT RIDER NO. 62, (4) RECOVERY OF 80% OF THE FEDERALLY-MANDATED COSTS ON A TIMELY BASIS AND APPROVAL OF THE USE OF A REGULATORY ASSET TO ACCRUE SUCH COSTS, WITH FINANCING COSTS, UNTIL THE COSTS ARE REFLECTED IN PETITIONER'S RATES, (5) AUTHORITY TO ACCRUE A REGULATORY ASSET FOR THE DEFERRAL OF 20% OF THE FEDERALLY-MANDATED COSTS ON AN INTERIM BASIS, WITH CARRYING COSTS, UNTIL THE APPLICABLE COSTS ARE REFLECTED IN PETITIONER'S BASE RETAIL ELECTRIC RATES, AND (6) AUTHORITY TO DEFER FUTURE ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE AND RETIREMENT-RELATED DEVELOPMENT, ENGINEERING, TESTING AND PRE-CONSTRUCTION COSTS.
