Attached for submission by Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), in accordance with 170 IAC 4-7 (IRP rules), is an electronic copy of I&M's 2024 Integrated Resource Plan (2024 IN IRP). I&M's 2024 IN IRP reflects the assessment of supply- and demand-side resources to cost-effectively meet I&M's customers' electric service needs. I&M will provide hard copies to the Commission upon request. I&M is also providing the technical appendix containing supporting documentation required by 170 IAC 4-7-2(c). I&M will provide access to the electronic data files to the parties that have executed a non-disclosure agreement.
