**Loraine Seyfried Named Deputy General Counsel**

**INDIANAPOLIS** – The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) recently named Loraine L. Seyfried Deputy General Counsel.

In her new capacity, she will oversee the administrative law judges and court reporters in addition to acting as the Commission’s Ethics Officer. Loraine will also provide general legal advice to the Commission and make recommendations on weekly assignments for newly filed cases.

“I expect the Office of General Counsel to continue, and improve upon, its tradition of conducting appropriate evidentiary hearings and providing legally sound and well-reasoned advice and orders for Commission approval,” said Loraine.

When asked what she looks forward to about the position, Loraine explained that she appreciates “the opportunity to work with the IURC on the broader public policy issues facing Indiana and the utility industry today.”

Loraine has served as an administrative law judge at the IURC since 2005. Before joining the Commission, she worked as an attorney and focused on environmental law.

An advocate of neither the public nor the utilities, the IURC is required by state statute to make decisions that balance the interests of all parties to ensure the utilities provide adequate and reliable service at reasonable prices.*
