Thank you for the valuable feedback received at the first technical conference on December 15, 2010. For those who were unable to attend, please note that customers, utilities, the Office of Utility Consumer Counselor and other interested parties were able to discuss issues to be included in the rule and begin a rough outline of what should go into a rule governing disputes.

Our office is now soliciting proposed language for the dispute resolution rule. If you have suggested language for this section of the rule, please email it to me **no later than** close of business on **Monday, January 17, 2011**. Our office will take the suggested language and formulate a draft rule. We hope to circulate this rule back to the interested parties by the first week of February.

At the next technical conference, we will do the following:

1. Discuss the language of the draft rule on dispute resolution.
2. Discuss what should go into the customer education section of the rule.
3. Discuss what should go into the notices section of the rule.
4. Discuss what should go into the tree replacement program section of the rule.
5. Discuss any remaining issues appropriate to the rule.

As in the first technical conference, please do not bring audio visual materials or presentations. This will not be a series of presentations but rather an informal discussion of possible rule sections.

The second technical conference is scheduled for **February 11, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission's Judicial Conference Room 222**. If you cannot attend the meeting or do not wish to speak, you can email comments for the Commission's review.
