

Pursuant to Indiana Code § 8-1.5-3-8.3(C), Petitioner, the City of Rushville and the Rushville City Utilities Board, by counsel, respectfully petition the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") for approval of the rate and charge difference between property within and property outside the corporate boundaries of the City of Rushville, Indiana ("City"). In support of this Petition, Petitioners States:

1. The current ordinance rates and charges for property within and property outside the City's corporate boundaries were adopted on March 20, 2012.
2. Attached as "Exhibit A" is a copy of the current ordinance setting rates and charges in effect of the City.
3. The works that are subject of this petition and the ordinance is wastewater utility.
4. The percentage difference between the rates and charges imposed on users of the works for service to property located outside the corporate boundaries of the City and to the property located with the corporate boundaries is fifty percent (50%).
5. The fifty percent (50%) figure is across the board regardless of the amount of consumption for those outside the corporate boundaries.
6. Petitioner considers and states that Indiana Code § 8-1.5-3-8.3 (c), among other statutes, to be applicable to the relief being requested in this Petition.
7. Geoffrey W. Wesling is counsel of record for Petitioners in this matter and is duly authorized to accept service of papers in this matter on behalf of the Petitioners.

Wherefore, the City of Rushville and the Rushville City Utility Board respectfully request that the commission issue an Order approving the percentage rate and charge difference between property within and property outside the corporate boundaries of the City of Rushville, Indiana and for any other just and reasonable relief.

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

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RUSHVILLE, INDIANA
2012-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSHVILLE, INDIANA,
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2009-3

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Rushville has determined it necessary to amend Ordinance 2009-3 to include out of town surcharges for sewer and water as follows;

In the event that the Council determines that it is necessary to extend service to customers outside of the City corporation limits, the surcharge for sewer and water shall be no greater than fifty percent (50%) of the rates and charges for those customers of the City within the corporation limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSHVILLE that Ordinance No. 2009-3 is hereby amended to include surcharges for sewer and water to customers outside the corporation limits.


SEVERABILITY OF PROVISIONS: If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be determined to be invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance and the application of its provisions to other persons not similarly situated or to the other circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

REPEAL OF PREVIOUS ORDINANCES: Any and all ordinances in conflict herewith shall be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF RUSHVILLE, INDIANA this Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signature by the City Council of the City of Rushville, Indiana, and as provided by law, and upon any further requirements under Indiana law.



(B) Each individual who requests services to be provided to their property from the Rushville City Utilities shall be required to pay a deposit in the sum of \$75, such deposit shall be refunded whenever service is disconnected and all charges then due and owing are paid.

(C) The Common Council authorizes the utility to borrow funds in connection with financing the costs of providing monies for making extensions, replacements and improvements to the water plant.
