ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

Request: The utility is proposing to eliminate the bi-monthly billing option pursuant to Indiana-American's obligations under the Settlement reached in Cause No. 44450, which was approved in the Commission's Final Order dated January 28, 2015.

Indiana-American is also reducing its Area One first rate block to offset any revenue increase that may have occurred with the elimination of bi-monthly billing.

Finally, Indiana-American proposes certain language changes on Tariff pages 9(a) and 12 for consistency with both its tariff and the utility's Rules and Regulations.
