**ORDER OF THE COMMISSION**

On April 22, 2026, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) issued an Interim Order in this Cause, approving Indiana Michigan Power Company’s (“Petitioner”) proposed alternative regulatory plan on a preliminary basis, pending the outcome of Petitioner’s filing in Michigan. Petitioner was ordered to notify the Commission through a compliance filing under this Cause within seven calendar days of an order being issued by the Michigan Public Service Commission.

On May 1, 2026, Petitioner filed a Notice of Final Order in Michigan Case and Request for Final Order (“Notice”). In its Notice, Petitioner notified the Commission it had received a final order in its Michigan filing and attached a copy of the order. Petitioner stated that the Michigan order is consistent with the Interim Order issued in this Cause and that the two orders can be feasibly implemented. Thus, Petitioner requested the Commission issue an order in this Cause, making its preliminary findings final.

The Commission, having considered the matter, finds that the interim designation of its April 22, 2026 Interim Order shall be removed and the order is made final.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION that:**

1. The determinations made in the Commission’s April 22, 2026 Interim Order are made final and Petitioner’s proposed alternative regulatory plan is approved as set forth therein.
2. This Order shall be effective on and after the date of its approval.
