ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

In its May 7, 2025 Order in Cause No. 46177, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) declined, with limited exceptions, to exercise its jurisdiction over Royerton Solar, LLC’s (“Royerton Solar”) proposed solar generation facility in Delaware County, Indiana.

On December 22, 2025, Royerton Solar filed its Notice of Suspension of Project Development under Cause No. 46177 and requested an order from the Commission terminating its declination of jurisdiction over Royerton Solar.

On March 4, 2026, the Commission initiated this cause and issued an order serving as notice to Royerton Solar that it intended to terminate its declination of jurisdiction ordered in Cause No. 46177. More than 15 days have passed since the Commission’s March 4, 2026 order, and no hearing has been requested. Accordingly, no formal public hearing in this cause is needed for the Commission’s action under Ind. Code §§ 8-1-2-72 and 8-1-2.5-7 to amend its order in Cause No. 46177 and resume the Commission’s exercise of its jurisdiction over Royerton Solar to the extent authorized by law and as the public interest requires.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION that:

1. The declination of jurisdiction over Royerton Solar and its construction, operation, and financing of its proposed solar generation facility, as ordered in the Commission’s May 7, 2025 Order in Cause No. 46177, is terminated.
2. Royerton Solar’s reporting requirements to the Commission under Cause No. 46177 are terminated.
3. The Commission reassumes its full jurisdiction over Royerton Solar to the extent it is subject to the Commission’s jurisdiction.
4. This Order will be effective on and after the date of its approval.
