Request: A revision to Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment Tracking Factors, to

be applied beginning with the April 2021 billing cycle.

In its most recent rate case (Cause No. 44472, Order issued December 17, 2014), Auburn was authorized to implement a two-part tracking mechanism for some rate classes to distinguish demand and energy costs. After approval, a consultant for Auburn found the tracking mechanism did not work as intended. Cause No. 44774 (Order issued July 18, 2016) was filed to remedy the problems in the original mechanism. This is the eighth filing since that Order clarifying the tracking mechanism.

The calculation of the adjustments includes the projected cost of wholesale power for April 2021 through August 2021 and the reconciliation of wholesale power purchased from January 2020

through May 2020.
