**Request:** I&M requests approval of amendments to its lighting Tariff O.L. (Outdoor Lighting). The proposed modifications, which would add two new LED lamp sizes and three new no-pole rates in a post top style fixture, will provide new energy efficient LED lighting options to new and existing customers. Customers that participate in I&M’s Tariff O.L. will have these new light options available to them, while customers within I&M’s service territory that currently provide their own outdoor lighting will also benefit if they choose I&M for their lighting needs.

**Customer Impact:** The new no-pole rates allow customers who pay for the installation of lighting facilities upfront to be charged only for a monthly light rental. The proposed monthly lighting charges for these new offerings are shown below.
