Request: NIPSCO proposes revisions to Rule 4 – Application, Service Request

or Contract and Rule 6 – Service Extensions and Modifications of its IURC Electric Service Tariff, Original Volume No. 15 ("Electric Tariff"). Specifically, the revisions (1) add clarifying language to Rule 4.1 – Written Application or Contract Required (Sheet No. 19) to confirm that the rule is applicable to a customer who seeks service equal to or greater than 50 megawatts, and (2) deleting Rule 6.4.7 – New Residential Development Procedures (Sheet No. 27) and creating a new Rule 6.5 – Special Agreement (Sheet No. 27) to similarly clarify that the prior Rule 6.4.7 is applicable to a Customer who seeks service equal to or greater than 50 megawatts and is also

applicable to the entire Rule 6 – Extensions and Modifications.

Customer Impact: No billing impact, changes only to rules and regulations of service.

Tariff Page(s) Affected: Original Sheets 19, 27, and 28.

Staff Recommendations: Requirements met, Staff recommends approval.
