Request: Approval of a Contract for Interruptible Power between I/N Tek LP and I&M as provided in Tariff C.S. – IRP2. The original contract form was approved in the Final Order in Cause No. 43878.

Customer Impact: The Contract allows for mandatory (capacity) and/or discretionary (energy) interruptions. Filed under seal and considered confidential is I&M’s fixed cost analysis demonstrating that all variable costs and a contribution to fixed costs are provided by the customer to I&M. No other customers are impacted by the amendment to the contract.
