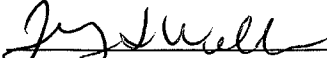

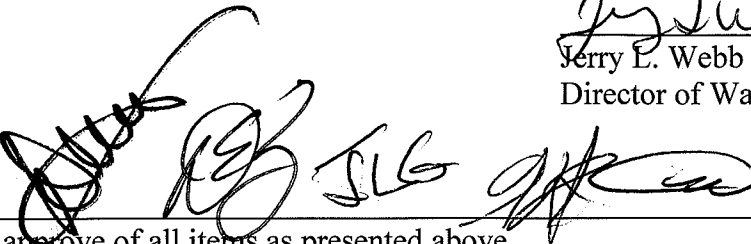

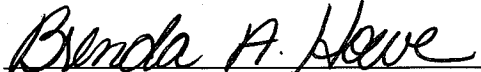

“A” Preliminaries

The following new miscellaneous items have been reviewed by staff members of the Commission and we recommend accepting them for filing.

1. Fountaintown Gas Company

The Utility proposes establishing the following tariff additions: 1) Rate STS - School Transportation Service; and 2) Nomination and Balancing Provisions – Appendix F. These additions will make transportation service available to any public school corporation (K through 12) facility or multiple public school corporations acting as a group. Summary billing will also be provided to allow each school corporation to receive one bill for all facilities under this new rate.

Customers under this rate will purchase gas supply and pipeline capacity from a supplier other than the Utility. The proposed rate schedule requires the Rate STS customer to:

- a. Pay the Utility for the cost of purchasing and installing electronic gas measurement devices and related communications equipment;
- b. Provide and maintain on the premises at the meter location electric and telephone service and related communications equipment;

Rates and Charges

The Transportation Charge for Rate STS will be equal to the last block of Commodity Charges for Commercial Service minus the base cost of gas. The Customer Charges are designed to be revenue neutral. Cost support has been provided. The rates and charges for Rate STS are as follows:

Customer Charge:	For meter sizes less than 800	\$100.00
	For meter sizes 800 and greater	\$150.00
Transportation Charge:	\$1.11/Dth	
Monitoring Charge:	Customer shall pay a Monitoring Charge of \$30.50 per month to cover remote metering requirements.

2. South Eastern Indiana Gas Company

The Utility proposes establishing the following tariff additions: 1) Rate STS - School Transportation Service; and 2) Nomination and Balancing Provisions – Appendix F. These additions will make transportation service available to any public school corporation (K through 12) facility or multiple public school corporations acting as a group. Summary billing will also be provided to allow each school corporation to receive one bill for all facilities under this new rate.

Customers under this rate will purchase gas supply and pipeline capacity from a supplier other than the Utility. The proposed rate schedule requires the Rate STS customer to:

- a. Pay the Utility for the cost of purchasing and installing electronic gas measurement devices and related communications equipment;
- b. Provide and maintain on the premises at the meter location electric and telephone service and related communications equipment;

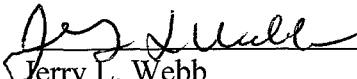
Rates and Charges

The Transportation Charge for Rate STS will be equal to the last rate block for General Service minus the base cost of gas. The Customer Charge is designed to be revenue neutral. Cost support has been provided. The rates and charges for Rate STS are as follows:

- Customer Charge: \$25.00
- Transportation Charge: \$2.0262/Dth
- Monitoring Charge: Customer shall pay a Monitoring Charge of \$30.50 per month to cover remote metering requirements.
