Since September 2005, the Indiana Supreme Court has created a [comprehensive list of potential jurors](#) available for jury service. The list is provided annually to counties free of charge. The Jury Management System (JMS) is a web-based system developed in 2007 and available to all courts without cost.

The JMS is available through the INcite website. Updates of the Supreme Court jury lists are imported into the JMS and, therefore, juror information is easily searchable and up-to-date. Counties can select jurors randomly for jury pools and panels; record exemptions, deferrals and disqualifications; and manage juror payment claims. The system prints labels and reports and exports data for use in other documents, such as mailings, questionnaires and other documentation. In the future, the system will provide a website for citizens to ascertain their jury service obligations via the Internet instead of calling the courthouse.

As of Summer 2016, seventy-two (72) counties are using the JMS. Counties that have not chosen to use the JMS can securely export the Supreme Court-approved master jury list or create and download jury pools from their master lists through the [INcite](#) website.
