**ORDER FOR INITIAL
CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

Pursuant to the Indiana Interim Commercial Court Rules, an Identifying Notice has been filed and therefore this case is provisionally assigned to the Commercial Court docket of Judge Heather Welch. Information regarding Commercial Court cases, rules, handbook, forms, etc. is available at <http://www.in.gov/judiciary/center/2944.htm>. An initial case management conference is set for **August 1, 2016 at 9:00 with one (1) hour allotted** in the Marion County Superior Court, Civil Division 1 located at 200 East Washington Street, Room W407, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204.

Interim Orders

Counsel who are managing the litigation, and who are able to make decisions regarding discovery and briefing of legal issues, must attend the initial case management conference in person.

Before the initial case management conference, the Court Orders counsel for all parties to confer in person or by telephone (no fewer than five days before the conference) and be prepared to discuss the issues to be set out in the Initial (joint) Case Management Proposed Order.¹

Counsel for Plaintiff must prepare a joint Initial Case Management Proposed

Order to be filed three court days prior to the initial case management conference.² The joint Initial Case Management Proposed Order is to include the following, if applicable in this case:

1. A list of all parties and counsel;
2. A statement as to whether additional parties are likely to be added and a proposed date by which all parties must be served;
3. An outline of the claims and cross-claims, and the parties against whom each claim is asserted, and the relief sought against each party;
4. Service lists and procedures for efficient service filing;
5. Whether any issues of jurisdiction or venue exist that might affect this court's ability to proceed with this case;
6. Applicability and enforceability of arbitration clauses;
7. A list of all related litigation pending in other courts, a brief description of any such litigation, and a statement as to whether any additional related litigation is anticipated;
8. A description of core factual and legal issues;
9. A description of legal issues that, if decided by the court, may simplify or further resolution of the case;
10. Preparation of a preliminary discovery plan, and a discussion of whether discovery should be conducted in phases or limited; and if so, the order of phasing or types of limitations on discovery; and
11. Whether particular documents relevant to the case can be exchanged by agreement of the parties. Whether information concerning relevant witnesses can be exchanged by agreement of the parties.
12. The parties' thoughts on the timing of ADR and how ADR might be integrated into the course of the litigation;
13. For insurance coverage cases and construction defect cases, an insurance coverage chart listing all insurance, including the names of the insured and insurance company, effective dates of the policy, policy limits, amount of monies

previously paid out on the policy, whether the policy limits have been exhausted, and whether the policy is primary, umbrella, etc.;

14. Procedures for the drafting of a Case Management Order, if appropriate;
15. The creation of a single master file for the litigation to eliminate the need for multiple filings of similar documents when related cases have common parties;
16. The appointment of a commercial court master to address discovery or other matters;
17. A plan for preservation of evidence;
18. A proposed discovery cut-off date; and
19. A target date and a time estimate for trial.

To the extent the parties are unable to agree on the matters to be addressed in the joint Initial Case Management Proposed Order, the positions of each party or of various parties shall be set forth separately and attached to the joint proposed order as an addenda.
