**LR50-AR00-MLR-22**  
**Court Alcohol and Drug Program Fees**  
**Drug Court User Fees**

- (A) All individuals ordered to enroll in the Marshall County Drug and Alcohol Program may be charged a fee for program services not to exceed the maximum fee set by Indiana Code § 12-23-14-16, as amended.
- (B) All individuals ordered to enroll in the Marshall County Drug Court through Marshall Superior Court No. 3 shall be assessed and pay the fees set by Indiana Code § 33-23-16-23, as amended. Drug Court fees shall include:
  - a. \$100.00 initial user fee,
  - b. \$50.00 monthly user fee assessed beginning on the second month of supervision.
- (C) Drug Court user fees shall be collected and transferred to the appropriate user fee fund established under I.C. §§ 33-37-8.
