ORDER APPOINTING JUDGE PRO TEMPORE

The Honorable Roger D. Davis, Judge of the Harrison Superior Court, has notified this Court of his resignation from the office effective at noon on August 23, 2014. As a result, we find that in the interests of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of that office. Further, this Court has been advised that the Honorable Curtis B. Eskew, Jr., a Senior Judge, is willing to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore*.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Honorable Curtis B. Eskew, Jr. is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Harrison Superior Court effective at 12:01 p.m. on August 23, 2014, until further order of this Court, such time as the Governor's appointee assumes office, or the newly elected judge of the Harrison Superior Court assumes office, whichever occurs first.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Eskew to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Harrison Superior Court. Judge Eskew shall be entitled to compensation for this service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to T.R. 63(D).

John Evans, Harrison Circuit Court, 300 North Capital Avenue, Corydon, IN 47112-0428; to the Hon. Curtis B. Eskew, Jr.; to the Division of State Court Administration and to the Indiana Judicial Center. The Clerk is also directed to post this Order on the Court's website
