

Order Amending Indiana Rules for Small Claims

Under the authority vested in this Court to provide by rule for the procedure employed in all courts of this state and this Court's inherent authority to supervise the administration of all courts of this state, Indiana Rules for Small Claims, Rule 12.1 is adopted as follows (deletions shown by ~~striking~~ and new text shown by underlining):

**Indiana Rules for Small Claims**

...

**Rule 12.1. Time to file Change of Judge**

In any court exercising small claims jurisdiction, a party shall have ten [10] days from the date of service of the notice of claim to file a change of judge. When a change occurs a new judge shall be selected as provided in Trial Rules 79 or 79.1.

This amendment shall take effect on January 1, 2017.
