Danny Lopez is the Chief of Staff for Indiana Lt. Governor Eric Holcomb. In this role, Danny is responsible for assisting the Lt. Governor with the management and leadership of the executive and business offices, and five state agencies including the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA), Indiana Office of Tourism Development (IOTD), Indiana Office of Defense Development (IODD), Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA), and the Indiana State Department of Agriculture (ISDA).

Danny previously served as Deputy then State Director for Indiana Senator Dan Coats. As State Director, Danny handled constituent concerns and was responsible for the Senator's schedule and travels while he was in the state. Danny served a dual role as Special Assistant to Governor Mike Pence, and Deputy Director of the Indiana Civil Rights Commission.

Outside the office, Danny is engaged with a number of different private and public organizations serving a true cross-section of Hoosiers. He was named to the Indianapolis Business Journal's prestigious Forty Under 40 list for 2016, was a Board Member on both the State of Indiana Charter School Board and the Greater Indianapolis YMCA. One of his most cherished roles was as the Statewide Outreach Subcommittee Co-Chair for the 2012 Super Bowl Committee.
