## This Week in Indiana History: The Death of Carol Jenkins September 17th, 1968

In a mid September evening, Rushville resident Carol Jenkins was selling encyclopedias door to door when she noticed someone following her in an automobile. She quickly took shelter at a nearby house, who's residents reported the suspicious vehicle to the police. After stating that they did not finding anyone fitting the description of the suspects, they left. Although the neighbors offered to let Jenkins stay with them, she decided to leave as well. Shortly thereafter, she was attacked and killed by an unknown assailant. The killing went unsolved for over thirty years, until Ku Klux Klan member Kenneth Richmond was turned in for the crime.
