## CHAPTER XLVIII.

AN ACT to establish a State Seminary, and for other purposes.

APPROVED, January 20, 1820.

On this week in 1820 Indiana University was established as a state seminary, becoming Indiana University in 1838. In 1824 they had

10 students. Today they have more than 550 academic programs and have graduated over 640,000 students.
