The application deadline for the Indiana State Historic Records Advisory Board's (SHRAB) Hoosier History Digitization Grants is *June 22*. This grant opportunity is for organizations that preserve and maintain historic collections of Indiana records.

Each grantee is eligible for up to \$5,000 and will be expected to provide a cash or in-kind match of at least 25 percent. This grant is open to libraries, local governments and nonprofits in Indiana that house and care for historic collections.
