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Issue identified with claims submitted with multiple payers

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has identified an issue with Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) compliant 837 transactions submitted with multiple other payer IDs that could impact provider

Providers and/or clearinghouses submitting HIPAA-compliant 837 transactions should ensure that when submitting claims with multiple other payers, the payer ID is unique.

Other payer ID information is submitted on the 837 transaction in:

- Loop 2330B Other Payer Name
- Segment NM1 Other Payer Name
- Data Element NM109 Other Payer Primary Identifier
- Electronic data interchange (EDI) file example NM1*PR*2*OTHER PAYER NAME*****PI*00000~

The following is an example of an incorrect submission with the same payer ID:

- Payer ID = 00190 (Name-Payer A) ■ Payer # 1
- Payer # 2 Payer ID = 00190 (Name-Payer B)

Claims submitted after Oct. 12, 2022, will be denied with explanation of benefits (EOB) 946 - Multiple payers submitted with same payer ID.
