IHCP revises direct service provider requirement for IOT of members with SUD diagnosis

Effective June 30, 2020, and in response to *House Enrolled Act 1326*, a licensed addiction counselor (LAC) or licensed clinical addiction counselor (LCAC) is no longer required to be a direct service provider when IOT (intensive outpatient treatment) is provided for an Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) member who has a substance use disorder (SUD) diagnosis. This is a revision to the IOT requirements (program standards) previously announced in *IHCP Bulletin BT201929*. All other requirements for IOT services will remain the same.
