IHCP updates PA policy for AED and WCD devices

Effective March 1, 2022, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) will be replacing the current IHCP prior authorization (PA) policy for automatic external defibrillator (AED) and wearable cardioverter defibrillator (WCD) devices.

These devices will remain subject to PA. However, for dates of service on or after March 1, 2022, both AEDs (procedure code E0617 – *External defibrillator with integrated electrocardiogram analysis*) and WCDs (procedure code K0606 – *Automatic external defibrillator, with integrated electrocardiogram analysis, garment type*) will be considered medically necessary when determined by a nationally recognized care guideline.
