

Additional providers may order diabetes selfmanagement and training services

Effective **Dec. 1, 2021**, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has expanded the providers that may order diabetes self-management and training services for IHCP members. In addition to physicians and podiatrists, the following providers may order services:

- Nurse practitioner Provider type 09, specialties 090, 091 and 092
- Clinical nurse specialist Provider type 09, specialty 093
- Certified nurse midwife Provider type 09, specialty 095
- Physician assistant Provider type 10, specialty 100



- Be medically necessary.
- Provided by healthcare professionals who are licensed, registered or certified under applicable Indiana law and who have specialized training in the management of diabetes.
- Ordered in writing by a physician, podiatrist, nurse practitioner, clinical nurse specialist, certified nurse midwife or physician assistant.

This policy change applies to dates of service on or after **Dec. 1, 2021**. The change applies to all IHCP programs, subject to limitations established for certain benefit packages.



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
