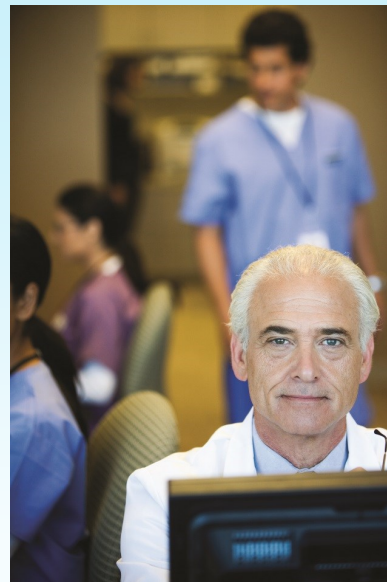

IHCP announces end to member continuous eligibility

As a result of the federal public health emergency, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) issued provider notices regarding temporary Medicaid policy changes. As a reminder, all individuals enrolled in Medicaid have received continuous ongoing eligibility with limited reasons for disenrollment (announced in *IHCP Bulletin BT202033*). Effective March 31, 2023, the continuous member eligibility will end. Individuals will be subject to standard member eligibility rules as of April 1, 2023.

The federal spending bill uncoupled Medicaid coverage protections from the federal public health emergency. Any further extension of the federal public health emergency itself will not impact the timing of returning to normal operations for Medicaid eligibility.

The federal public health emergency is ongoing, and this change only impacts continuous eligibility at this time. Cost-sharing and other provisions related to the public health emergency will be addressed at a later date.
