FSSA recommends managed care entities to serve future Indiana Pathways for Aging members

The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning is pleased to announce the managed care entities (MCEs) that have been recommended for award for the opportunity to serve members in the Indiana Pathways for Aging Program (Pathways). The following MCEs can begin negotiations and implementation:

- Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield (Anthem)
- Humana Healthy Horizons in Indiana (Humana)
- Molina Healthcare of Indiana (Molina)
- United Healthcare Community Plan (UHC)

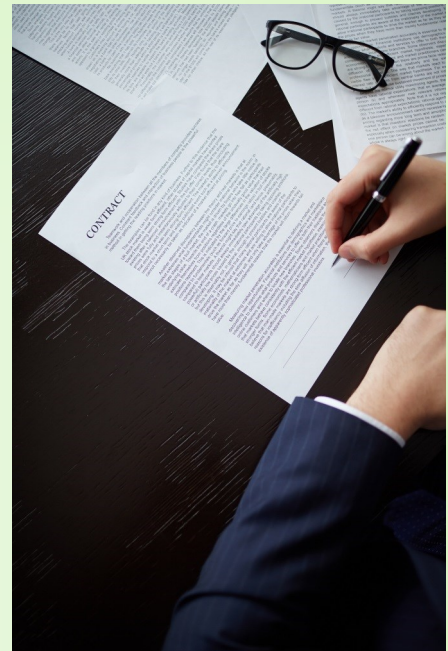
The MCE selection comes after years of collaborative efforts across the FSSA, stakeholders and providers to design a strong program that will ensure Hoosiers receive high-quality care. Each of the awarded MCEs have demonstrated experience and success in Medicaid managed care and long-term services and supports through a competitive procurement process. These MCEs will be integral to make it easier for individuals to get home services, create seamless coordination between Medicaid and Medicare, and to better serve our growing aging population.

The Pathways program will be a managed long-term service and supports program for Indiana's Medicaid enrollees who are 60 years of age and older and are eligible for Medicaid on the basis of age, blindness or disability.

The Pathways program has the following three goals:

- **Person-Centered Services and Supports** – Develop service plans and deliver services in a manner that is person-centered, member-driven, and holistic; involves caregivers; and addresses social determinants of health.
- **Ensuring Smooth Transitions** – Ensure continuity of care and seamless experiences for members as they transition into the Pathways program or among providers, settings or coverage types.
- **Access to Services (Member Choice)** – Assure timely access to appropriate services and supports to enable members to live in their setting of choice and promote their well-being and quality of life.

The program will go live in 2024. More information will be provided in future IHCP publications.



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
