IHCP to stop recognizing temporary COVID-19 licenses May 11, 2023

In alignment with the conclusion of the federal public health emergency, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) will no longer recognize all temporary licenses authorized by the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency for coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) emergency registries as of May 11, 2023. These licenses are identified by the following: License No. CV#####. All these temporary licenses will expire on May 11, 2023, and the IHCP will begin taking action to disenroll any practitioners who do not have an unlimited license to practice on file with the IHCP after this date.

Providers are strongly encouraged to ensure that they have an unlimited license to practice on file with the IHCP. Providers may update their licensure information online using the [IHCP Provider Healthcare Portal](#) or by paper using the *IHCP Provider Enrollment Recertification of Licenses and Certifications Form* (form and instructions available on the [Recertify Provider Enrollment Licenses and Other Certifications](#) page at in.gov/medicaid/providers).
