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FSSA makes changes to pharmacy supply limits for *HIP Basic* members

Effective Oct. 1, 2022, the prescription drug supply limit for *Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) Basic* permanently extends from 30 days to 90 days. The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) made these changes to align *HIP Basic* prescription drug plans with *HIP Plus* prescription drug plans.

There are no changes to cost-sharing requirements and members will continue to be exempt from copayments for preventive care in accordance with *Code of Federal Regulations 45 CFR 147.130*.

HIP Basic members have been receiving this benefit through the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) public health emergency (see *IHCP Bulletin BT202021*). *HIP Basic* members will continue to receive this benefit permanently following return to normal operations.



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
