IHCP adds new secondary specialties for waiver providers

The Indiana Health Coverage Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has added new secondary specialties for waiver providers, which are effective retroactively to July 1, 2024.

Providers can now add these secondary specialties to their provider profile on the [IHCP Provider Healthcare Portal](#), accessible from the homepage at [in.gov/medicaid/providers](#). No application fee or fingerprint background check is required for these new secondary specialties; they are all considered limited risk.

Table 1 lists the new secondary specialties and the associated waiver provider specialties.

As a reminder, before a secondary waiver specialty can be added to a provider's profile, the provider must be certified for the corresponding service by the appropriate agency: the Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) for Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI), Health and Wellness (H&W), or Indiana PathWays for Aging (PathWays) waiver services, or the Bureau of Disabilities Services (BDS) for Family Supports Waiver (FSW) or Community Integration and Habilitation (CIH) waiver services. For OMPP certification, providers must submit the request through the [OMPP HCBS Certification Portal](#), as described in *IHCP Bulletins* [BT202456](#) and [BT202472](#). For BDS certification, providers must submit the request to BDSProviderServices@fssa.in.gov. A copy of the certification letter must be submitted when adding the secondary specialty to an IHCP enrollment.

The [IHCP Provider Enrollment Type and Specialty Matrix](#) and [IHCP Provider Enrollment Risk Category and Application Fee Matrix](#) will be updated with these new waiver provider secondary specialties.
