IHCP covers ZIMHI naloxone injection (procedure code J2311) for EMS transportation providers

As announced in Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) Bulletins [BT202058](#) and [BT202063](#), the IHCP reimburses Emergency Medical Services (EMS) provider agencies for administering naloxone. Effective for dates of service (DOS) on or after June 7, 2024, the IHCP will reimburse EMS transportation providers (provider specialty 260 – *Ambulance*) for Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code J2311 – *Injection, naloxone hydrochloride (zimhi), 1 mg*.

Prior authorization (PA) is not required. The applicable National Drug Code (NDC) for the product used must be included on the claim, along with the ZIMHI HCPCS code. Administration of the ZIMHI injection should be billed using procedure code and modifier 96372 U2. Coverage applies to both managed care and fee-for-service (FFS) delivery systems. Naloxone and its administration are carved out of the FFS transportation brokerage arrangement, meaning that, for FFS members, transportation providers must submit these claims directly to Gainwell rather than to the FFS transportation broker.
