# **Corrections announced to previously published Family Planning Eligibility Program coverage**

Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) Bulletin <u>BT2025135</u> announced upcoming coverage changes for the Family Planning Eligibility program and the corresponding presumptive eligibility (PE) plan, PE – Family Planning Services. This bulletin corrects and replaces <u>BT2025135</u>.

For dates of service (DOS) on or after Oct. 30, 2025, **only** the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT<sup>®1</sup>) procedure codes listed in Table 1 will be removed from coverage for Family Planning Eligibility Program and PE – Family Planning Services members. The CPT procedure codes listed in Table 2 and the International Classification of Diseases (ICD) diagnosis code listed in Table 3 will **continue to be covered** under both programs for DOS on or after Oct. 30, 2025.



Table 1 – **Procedure codes no longer covered** for the Family Planning Eligibility Program, effective for DOS on or after Oct. 30, 2025

Procedure code	Code description	
53230	Excision of urethral diverticulum (separate procedure); female	
53260	Excision or fulguration; urethral polyp(s), distal urethra	

Table 2 – **Procedure codes that will remain covered** for the Family Planning Eligibility Program for DOS on or after Oct. 30, 2025 (these codes were included in BT2025135 in error)

Procedure code	Code description	
71045	Radiologic examination, chest; single view	
87101	Culture, fungi (mold or yeast) isolation, with presumptive identification of isolates; skin, hair, or nail	

Table 3 – **Diagnosis code that will remain allowable** for the Family Planning Eligibility Program for DOS on or after Oct. 30, 2025 (this code was included in BT2025135 in error)
