## IHCP reminds providers the previous Emergency Detention Order process expires June 30, 2025

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) reminds providers that the process for emergency detention orders (EDOs), for both fee-for-service (FFS) and managed care members, set forth in *IHCP Bulletins* [BT202468](#) and [BT2024104](#), will expire June 30, 2025. This is in accordance with *House Enrolled Act 1216* (HEA 1216) and *Indiana Code IC 12-15-5-13.5*.

Providers are encouraged to notify the member's managed care entity (MCE) or Acentra Health for FFS members, when the member is under an EDO. This is part of the standard utilization review process and factors into a medical necessity determination.

Providers may contact the member's MCE for questions and concerns. Providers with members in FFS Medicaid should contact Acentra Health at 866-725-9991.
