

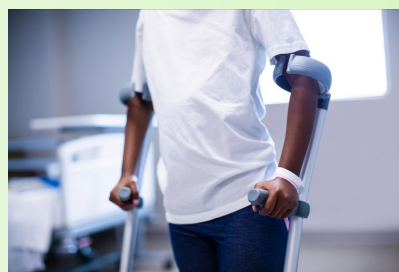

IHCP announces end to DME/HME 15-month capped rental period

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is announcing the end of the durable medical equipment (DME)/home medical equipment (HME) 15-month capped rental period.

Effective immediately, and applying retroactively to dates of service (DOS) on or after **Jan. 1, 2025**, all DME and HME that were previously subject to a 15-month capped rental period have been changed to a 10-month capped rental period. Any DME or HME that is subject to a capped rental period and has been rented for a period of 10 months is considered purchased by the member. This change applies to DME and HME in both the fee-for-service (FFS) and managed care delivery systems.
