Instructions

The Recovery Housing Program applications may receive a maximum of 65 program specific points.

The applicant must:

1. Complete this form, providing current information specific to the individual community.
2. Previously submitted information must have updated dates, signatures and current information for the applicable quarter to be considered eligible for these points
3. **Attach documents that support the statement for each filled out section. The documents must be attached to this completed form and submitted as a single uploaded file in GMS. The submission must be titled "RHP Program Specific Form".**

Awarded to non-entitlement communities including cities, towns or counties. The applicant must complete Section 1

SECTION 3: Beds Available to Pregnant Women or Women with Dependent Children

(Max. 15 Points)

Awarded to communities that increase the number of new beds available to pregnant women or women with dependents.

The applicant must:

- 1) Provide a narrative 3 to 4 sentences detailing the number of new beds that will be made available to either pregnant women or women with dependents or both.
- 2) Provide relevant documents that demonstrate the commitment to increase the stated number of beds by the facility.

SECTION 4: Individuals with Justice Involvement

(Max. 10 Points)

Awarded to communities that increase the number of new beds to people involved in court ordered rehabilitation.

The applicant must:

- 1) Provide a narrative 3 to 4 sentences detailing the number of new beds that will be made available to people involved in court ordered rehabilitation.
- 2) Provide relevant documents that demonstrate the commitment to increase the stated number of beds by the facility.

Awarded to communities that increase the number of new beds to veterans.

- 2) Provide relevant documents that demonstrate the commitment to increase the stated number of beds by the facility.

SECTION 6: Project Sustainability

(Max. 15 Points)

Awarded to communities that committee funds from the National Opioid Settlement Funds to be used as project match.

The applicant must:

- 1) Provide a narrative detailing the committee funds from the National Opioid Settlement Funds to be used as project match.
- 2) Provide relevant match documents that demonstrate the committeemen of the funds.

SECTION 7: Bonus Points

(Max. 25 Points)

Awarded to applicants who demonstrate a commitment to supporting residents in recovery by utilizing medication-assisted treatment (MAT) for substance use disorders.

- A. **Medication Support Policies** Applicants must attach the written policies that actively encourage and support the use of medications for substance use disorder treatment. These policies should explicitly include, but are not limited to:
 - Nicotine replacement therapies
 - Long-acting injectable medications
 - Daily oral medications
- B. **Trauma-Informed Care Policies** Applications must attach the written policies that incorporate a trauma-informed care approach into their organizational practices and policies to provide oversight over people in need of substance use disorder.

The Applicant must:

- 1) In 3-5 sentences, summarize how the program supports residents in recovery through the acceptance of Medically Assisted Treatment (MAT) and the incorporation of trauma informed approaches in policies and procedures.
- 2) Provide relevant attached written policies from the organization.
