COMMENTS INVITED ON CITIZENS WATER RATES

The OUCC has until October 13 to file testimony in the <u>Citizens Water rate case</u>. In the meantime, our attorneys and technical staff are busy reviewing the request. Consumers have the chance to speak on the record at the IURC's upcoming public field hearing, set for <u>September 16</u> at Emmerich Manual High School. The OUCC is also inviting <u>written consumer comments</u>.
