Can electric and natural gas utilities disconnect customers for non-payment during the winter? The State of Indiana has a winter shut-off moratorium, but it only applies in specific situations. Our overview can help. Our website also has a more detailed fact sheet on disconnection rules for regulated utilities, along with billing and energy efficiency tips that can benefit all consumers.
