PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS,** water is a finite resource that is vital to humans; and
- WHEREAS,** well-maintained green spaces are important to the health and well-being of communities and individuals; and
- WHEREAS,** abundant supplies of affordable food and fiber raise the standard of living for all citizens; and
- WHEREAS,** appropriate irrigation technology, combined with best practices, can sufficiently reduce water usage and runoff while creating healthy lawns, landscaping, and sports turf; and
- WHEREAS,** appropriate irrigation technology, combined with best practices, can sufficiently improve water use efficiency and reduce runoff while achieving greater agricultural yields per acre foot of water used; and
- WHEREAS,** July is a peak month for the use of water for irrigation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael R. Pence, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim July 2014 as

SMART IRRIGATION MONTH

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
