Question:

when an Indiana resident is hospitalized in Kentucky, do our physical therapists taking that Indiana resident to their home for a home evaluation need to be licensed in Indiana in order to do so legally and charge for it? Or are they covered by being licensed in Kentucky and providing care to a person that is still considered an inpatient in a Kentucky facility? Thank you in advance for your consideration and response, Ashley Minton, PT, DPT Manager of Rehabilitation Owensboro Health Regional Hospital

**Answer:**

Yes, they would need to hold an Indiana license or the compact privilege as those services are occurring in the state and the requirements are based on the location of the patient for telehealth and physical practice. Please refer to the telehealth laws for Indiana and the Indiana Physical Therapy laws

**E. DOT Physical**

**Question:**

Requesting a letter be issued by the Physical Therapy Board of the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency so that I can add an Indiana location to perform DOT Physical Exams that I am performing in my home state of Ohio and Kentucky. I have another colleague, William Beck, who has a PT license in Indiana and wants to begin performing DOT Physical Exams as well.

**Answer:**

Per IC 25-27-1-1 (d) and 842 IAC 1-1-1 (g) the board determined that a Physical Therapist can do these types of evaluations for the DOT and is within their scope of practice.
