She is licensed to sell health insurance and she will be starting that.
She sees a counselor once a week and does the online support group
Osborne asks about when she entered into Vision of Hope if she was aware of
what would happen if she drank, and she stated no
What happens if you relapse in this current counselling, and she stated she would
lose her kids. She has to take a breathalyzer every two hours

What does the accountability look like outside of counseling and her mom and brother are her support system.

State has no objection modifying the language to remove Vision of Hope but would like to see stronger language about sobriety or maybe a longer monitoring before she returns back to PT
