1. Janet Baugh 28106159 A/C, 71001604A: Baugh appeared with counsel Lorie Brown for disclosure of a medical malpractice case on her RN/APRN application renewal. There was a documentation issue regarding a patient who, after the visit, had a pulmonary embolism and died. She worked at that place of employment for many years, and she was not terminated. Ms. Brown indicated that the medical review panel in the criminal case did not refer to the Board, but that there was a settlement. The panel did find that Baugh failed to meet standard of care in this case. She reported that she has had no other employment or performance related issues. Baugh provided several exhibits, including CEs and letters of reference/support. She expressed that this incident has caused her to bolster her documentation practices and that she would refer more readily to the ED. She currently works at an urgent care where she has worked for 16 years. The ALJ recommended renewal of both licenses free and clear. Mitigating circumstances: no prior discipline or work related issues, Baugh's actions did not proximately result in the patient's death (high risk, medically complex patient who was instructed to go to ED), medical review panel did not refer to Board, completion of CE, letters of reference, excellent employment evaluation, settlement did not tap into the medical malpractice fund.

- 4. Nina Blessing 27059394A: Blessing appeared for an LPN reinstatement application. She previously came before the Board in 2022 on a reinstatement application because her LPN expired in 2012. At that time, the Board required that Blessing complete an LPN refresher course. She admitted that she never completed the course. She reports that she has been out of practice since 2012. Presently she works in addictions with drug court. She is a peer recovery coach and would like to return to practice to work in MAT/addictions. She has an expunged criminal conviction from 2012 and came before the Board in 2013 on her license renewal. The Board denied renewal at that time. The ALJ recommended that Blessing be required to either return to school or take NCLEX review course with predictor or green light, and then take and pass NCLEX again. and the refresher course with clinical component, If she completes either pathway, license to be issued free and clear. Mitigating factors: only one criminal case, acknowledgement of history of addiction, continuing participation in recovery personally and professionally, self-reported sobriety for 13 years, expungement of criminal case.

- 6. Amber Kling**28197064A: Kling appeared for a positive response on her RN renewal application. She was suspected of diverting narcotics so she was subjected to urine drug screen. She tested negative for any type of narcotics (no diversion proven), but positive for THC. She was terminated. She self-reported to ISNAP who provided an opinion that she did not meet criteria for monitoring. She now abstains from using marijuana. Her only other criminal case was from over 20 years ago when she had a OWI at age 21. Kling now works at an outpatient surgery center since June 2025, who hired her with knowledge of her previous termination. She reports that she's never had workplace discipline. The ALJ recommended renewal free and clear. Mitigating factors: self-referral to ISNAP, didn't meet criteria for monitoring, candor in disclosing termination to her current employer and Board, no prior workplace discipline.

- 7. Hope Chiamopoulos**28198012A: Chiamopoulos appeared for a positive response on her RN renewal application. She disclosed a criminal diversion related to an incident on New Year's Eve 2025 where she "drank too much" and engaged in disorderly conduct. No one else was arrested. There were children present at the incident (aged 17, 19, and 15). She presumes that a neighbor called the police. She reports that she hasn't consumed alcohol since the date of the incident. Before that, she drank casually/socially. She was under additional stress due to her breast cancer, which she reported resulted in a double mastectomy. The substance use evaluation through her criminal diversion resulted in the lowest level of concern regarding substance abuse. The diversion agreement is set to run through April 2026. She's been a nurse since 2011, but is not currently working. She was planning to attend school to become an NP but the criminal conviction plus her cancer has derailed that plan. The ALJ recommended renewal on probation for a minimum of the completion of her diversion. No ISNAP evaluation due to candor with the ALJ and the evaluation she already received through court. No active practice due to the fact that she is not actively working due to her cancer diagnosis and treatment. Submission of personal reports, self-signed board order, completion of 6 CEs in self-care and coping. She acknowledges behavior and has not worked since 2024.
- 8. Jaklin Fleurima, Application #4285712: Failed to appear. Reschedule.
- 9. Mark Dyer, 28156733A, 7100174A/C CONTINUED
- 10. Anya Bright, Application #4288871: Bright applied for a license preapproval. She is currently enrolled in nursing school with two semesters left. She has a criminal case resulting from an OWI on Cinco de Mayo (5/5/2024) where she was charged with Operating a vehicle w/ alcohol concentration to .15 or more. Sentenced to 1 year probation and ACP/ADS program. The ALJ recommended issuing an opinion that the criminal conviction is not disqualifying, but that a future Board might impose stipulations or discipline at the time of issuance.
- 11. Kelly Lehman, Application #4289285: Lehman appeared for Licensure Preapproval application. On September 21, 2011, she was convicted of operating a vehicle while intoxicated (BAC 0.08). She completed alcohol classes and victim impact panel; she completed her probation. On May 23, 2022, she was convicted again of operating a vehicle while intoxicated (BAC 0.12). She completed alcohol classes, victim impact panel and probation. The ALJ recommended issuing an opinion that the criminal conviction is not disqualifying, but that a future Board might impose stipulations or discipline at the time of issuance.
- 12. Dorothy McNeil, Application #4284018: McNeil appeared for RN application by Examination. She graduated on December 22, 2017, she has taken the NCLEX 5 times and failed. The ALJ recommended denial with the recommendation that she return to school.
- 13. Sofiya Paarlberg-Musleh, Application #4229860: Applicant appeared for RN application by Examination. She graduated in May 2002, she has taken the NCLEX 3 times and failed. The ALJ recommended denial with the recommendation that she return to school.
- 14. Tammi Hipsher, 27041242A: CONTINUED

- 15. Barbara Delagrange, Application #4286495: Delagrange appeared for RN license by Examination. She graduated in May 2006. She has taken the NCLEX three times and failed. The ALJ recommended denial with the recommendation that she return to school.
- 16. Busola Williams, Application #4246503: Busola is appearing for a RN license by Examination Foreign NE. She graduated on 5/3/2001. She has not sat for the exam. The ALJ recommended denial with the recommendation that she return to school. Williams last worked as a nurse in Nigeria in 2015. Due to the length of time since she last worked, plus never having taken NCLEX, the ALJ recommended denial with the recommendation that she return to school.
