Rule Change Status – Greg, Susan, Amy and Donald met to respond to questions that OMB had and submitted those responses back.

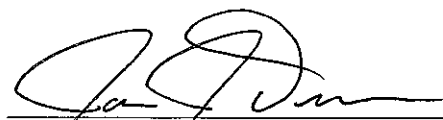
Alternative Pathways to Licensure – tabled thru the NCEES Annual Meeting.

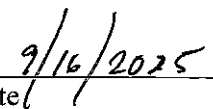
