1. LaTivia Carr, Lic# 27051260A* - **VACATED**
2. Cheyenne Miller, App# 4343871*- Applicant is appearing for a licensure preapproval for LPN. She was convicted of DUI in April of 2024. She was celebrating her birthday and decided to drive after a few drinks. She also lost her sister and was going through a divorce at the time. She completed her criminal probation and continues therapy. Based on the facts presented today, the ALJ recommended issuing an opinion that the criminal conviction is not disqualifying, but that a future Board might impose stipulations or sanctions at the time of issuance.

She graduated from Chamberlain in March 2026. She passed NCLEX April 2026. She entered into a pretrial diversion and She has a job offer Riley Children hospital starting on May 18th. The ALJ recommends to issue the license free and clear.
7. Tiwana Lee-Somerville, App# 4350534: Applicant is appearing for RN by examination. Education is 10+ years, she graduated from ITT Technical Institute in 2015. She has failed the RN NCLEX 4 times. She has testing anxiety. The ALJ recommendation is to deny and go back to school.
8. Jill Kinder, App# 4351162: Applicant is appearing for RN by examination. Education is 7+ years, she graduated from Ivy Tech Muncie in 2018. She has failed the RN NCLEX 3 times. She has high test anxiety. Her husband had cancer and put on hold of not testing right away.

She currently has an active LPN license. The ALJ recommendation is to deny and go back to school.

10. Nekeysha Sanders, App# 4358882: Applicant is appearing for RN by examination. Education is 7+ years, she graduated from ITT Technical Institute Indianapolis in March 2017. She has failed the NCLEX once. She had an auto accident and put off testing. The ALJ recommendation is to deny and go back to school.
11. Vinetta Gray, App# 4362849: Applicant is appearing for RN by examination. Education is 7+ years, she graduated from Medtech College Indianapolis in April 2015. She has failed the NCLEX twice. She was taking care of her mom fighting cancer. The ALJ recommendation is to deny and go back to school.
12. Tara Vash, App# 4365526: Applicant is appearing for LPN by examination. Education is 7+ years, she graduated from Vincennes University in August 2013. She has failed the NCLEX 4 times. The ALJ recommendation is to deny and go back to school.
13. Shelby Marx, App# 4365254: Applicant is appearing for RN by examination. Education is 7+ years, she graduated from Vincennes University in May 2018. She has failed the NCLEX 3 times. The ALJ recommendation is to deny and go back to school.

She has been working as a home health aid for the last two years. The ALJ recommendation is to either (1) do an NCLEX review course with a green light or 95% predictor score, take and pass NCLEX, then complete a nursing refresher course with clinical component, OR (2) go back to nursing school.

30. Mark Dyer, Lic# 28156733A: Applicant is appearing for RN reinstatement. He has been expired since 10/31/2017. The practice that he was working at was billing for Medicare for site visits and physical therapy and billing. He was an employee of the practice. On June 11, 2021, in the United States District Court for the Western District of Kentucky, Respondent was convicted of the following federal felony offenses: Conspiracy – Unlawful Distribution and Dispensing of Controlled Substances; Conspiracy – Money Laundering; Health Care Fraud – Physical Therapy; and Conspiracy – Health Care Fraud. He was sentenced to five years in prison and an additional three years of supervised release on March 29, 2023. He currently works as a CDL driver. He has completed the nursing refresher course and lab. The ALJ recommendation is to either (1) do an NCLEX review course with a green light or 95% predictor score, take and pass NCLEX, then complete a nursing refresher course with clinical component, OR (2) go back to nursing school. The license would be reinstated on indefinite probation for the length of his criminal probation or (24) months, whichever is longer. No supervisory roles and must be supervised, no home health, no school nurse, self-reports or employer quarterly reports, signed board order, 16 months of active practice prior to petitioning, keep board apprised of his contact info, any new arrests, new terminations. Mr. Dyer agrees to these terms.
31. Christy Rossman, App# 4363719: Applicant is appearing for RN by examination. She was revoked in 2015 due to noncompliance of ISNAP RMA and is reapplying. She was terminated from Wishard Hospital after more than 8 years as a critical care nurse approximately 2012. She self-enrolled in ISNAP and was provided with an RMA. She had a brief period that she stayed at home with her family. She worked in Progressive ICU at Community South Hospital for approximately 9 months. She was then terminated due to noncompliance with RMA after a positive test for alcohol. Her RN license was revoked January 15, 2015 due to noncompliance following an OWI. She was also working at Kohl's during this time and took items without paying for them. She was charged with conversion and has since been expunged. She was removed from the OIG exclusionary list and was cleared to practice per the OIG. She has since received inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation. Her sobriety date is August 8, 2021. She provided letter of recommendation from supervisor. She attended therapy but currently not in therapy. She relies on family. The ALJ recommends that she either go back to school or she completes NCLEX review course with a green light or 95% predictor score, take and pass NCLEX, then complete a nursing refresher course with clinical component. The license would be issued on indefinite probation no less than (24) months, engage with ISNAP, RMA if required, signed board order, quarterly reports, no supervisory roles and no unsupervised roles like home health, school nurse, (12) CEUs selfcare and coping, (12) CEUs in impaired nursing, (12) CEUs in professionalism and ethics. 12 months of active nursing. Mitigating factors: transparency, sobriety length, work history length, support of supervisors, accountability, removal from OIG list.
