### Senate honors local station WTLC on 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary

INDIANAPOLIS –The Indiana State Senate honored WTLC-FM Monday for the station's forty years of service to the Indianapolis Community. State Senator Jean Breaux (D-Indianapolis), Senate Sponsor of House Resolution 43, said the award-winning station sets a standard for entertainment and public service.

"Not only do they provide us with great entertainment, but WTLC provides a great public service as a venue for raising awareness on so many on issues of importance to our community," Breaux said. "It is truly a cornerstone for the Indianapolis community."

WTLC-FM became the first full time radio station serving the Indianapolis Black Community in January 1968. The station has participated in numerous public service campaigns, including the 1975 and 1976 "Because We Care" immunization campaign, 1987's "Baby Love for Healthy Babies" program and the 2006 "Stop the Violence" campaign. The station has also participating in fundraising events for charities including the Mozel Sanders Thanksgiving Dinner, United Negro College Fund, NAACP, Operation PUSH and Martin University.
