#### Our Students

- Current enrollment of 352 students from all over the State of Indiana
  - Early Childhood Education and K-12 students (18 months to 21 years old)
- 72% of ISD students have additional disabilities
- Approximately 80 residential students who live on campus through the school week
- ISD is expected to meet all requirements as indicated for public education (DOE)
